Sermon-Based Homework

Please answer the following questions before attending your Life Group to better engage in discussion. *If you are not in a Life Group at this time, answering the following questions will be valuable to you in greater understanding and application of the message presented in church.*

Matthew 7:7 talks about asking, seeking and knocking. Thinking from a parent's point of view (use your imagination if you are not a parent):

1. What kind of things would you like your children to request from you?
2. How would like your children to ask you for these things?
3. Would you want something in return for the things you give your children?
4. Would you give your children the cheapest or best version of what they asked for (if money was no object)?
5. Would you expect your children to be grateful for more than the moment they receive what they have been given?
6. Would you expect your children to have a relationship with you because you are their parent and provide for them (Talk to you, ask advise, spend time with you)?
7. Ask these same questions of yourself regarding God as your parent; does it change your attitude about how and what you ask Him for?
