Leader Questions

L.G. Bonding Question

If you were asked to be a missionary, what would be your greatest fear?

From the Sermon: Spotlight on Spain

Share one thing about this weekend's sermon that most interested you, stood out or touched you personally.

From the Homework

Read each question from "Bring It Home" out loud and give time for participants to share if they wish. Ask if anyone applied last week's assignment and began handing out supply bags to the homeless.

Application/Assignment

- This weekend our missionaries from Spain spoke and you were given the opportunity to participate in several ways to help support missions. Share your intentions with the group.
- This is a great opportunity to review our DNA from Acts 2:42...Read it out loud. The passage talks about the teaching of the apostles. Name different ways that people learn.
- Name some things people use to teach others.
- Pastor Mike Voudouris is in Iraq and has requested golf balls...how does that help him spread the gospel?
- Discuss various ways to support foreign missionaries and Pastor Mike in creative ways
Examples: sending toiletries, games, or snacks that they can share with others.
- As a group, fill a box for a missionary, pray over it, and mail it with an encouraging note. Keep a picture of the missionary in your Bible to remind you to pray for them during your devotion time
- As an individual, resolve to support missions in a particular way on a monthly basis.
